

Care Sheet - White Lined Gecko



Origin: New Guinea, Indonesia, India, Solomon Islands

Lifespan: Typically 3-5 years. Under excellent conditions and proper care some specimens can live in excess of 5 years to approx. 10 years.

Diet: Crested Gecko Diet, Dusted Crickets/Mealworms (vitamin and calcium dusted), some mashed fruits including bananas and non-citrus fruit. Feed every other day, 3-5 days a week.

Size: 10-11 inches (with males being a bit larger)

Habitat: Arboreal, Trees and forests of New Guinea, Indonesia, India, and the Solomon Islands

Temperature: Daytime temperatures should range between 75F and 85F with a basking spot of around 90F. Night temperatures should range between 70F and 75F ideally.

Humidity: Humidity should be kept between 70 – 80 on a hygrometer.

Housing: Tall terrarium, (Hatchling/Juvenile – 12"x12"x18" ** Adults – 18"x18"x24" or 24"x18"x36") Provide lots of hiding plants and climbing material like vines and cork bark. Use jungle earth or cocoa fiber as a substrate as it holds humidity well (keep an eye out for mold with high humidity). Provide a vertical hide with moss in it to help with shedding and humidity.

Active at: Nocturnal (No UVB bulb required for these geckos)
